Hints and Tips

- ✓ If you have several promotions to manage (or to create leading promotions), you may find it quicker to use the Bulk Promotion Maintenance Utility instead; refer to the [PRO-2i Create Bulk Promotions or Deals Fact Sheet](#).

You'll still use the **HOS Pricing Promotion** tab to:

- create percentage-off promotions
- fix a promotion saved with the wrong **Indicator, Date, Locations, or Affect**.

- ✓ Click  on the **Item** tab to set the following defaults:

- To return to the **Item** tab after saving changes.
- To set the source used to calculate recommended price on the **Promotions** tab.
- To set the **Item** tab to display only 1 record per EAN
- To set which zones display & their order on the screen.


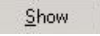

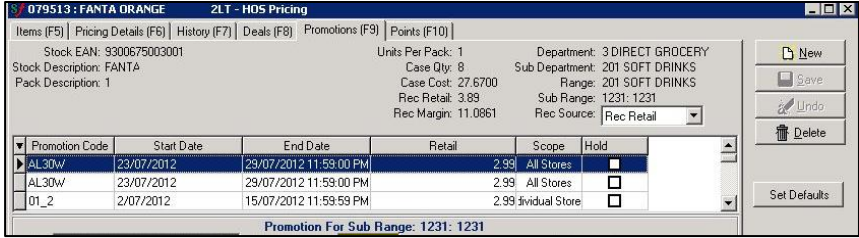
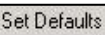
- ✓ You can create (or have hosted) **multiple promotions** with the same start date/time and Promotion ID, for the same or different stores.
 - The lowest price will apply at POS (which might be normal price if it's cheaper than the promotion!).
 - A HOST ticket will still print for the more expensive promotion/s, but should be ignored.

HOS Price Promotions

A promotion is a special retail price for a period of time, to promote or clear excess stock of a product, sub-range, or even the entire department.

Procedure to Create a New Price Promotion

Refer to page 3 to edit or delete a promotion.

<p>1. From the Tools menu, select Stock Functions -> HOS Pricing.</p> <p><i>*Alternatively, select the Show HOS Pricing check box if you're on the Stock screen.*</i></p>	
<p>2. Use the search fields to return the product/s that you want to put on promotion.</p>	
<p>3. Click  to display the search results.</p> <p><i>*To change or narrow your criteria, simply make the new selections (you can click Clear to remove all previous selections), and click Show again; the results override the previous products displayed.*</i></p> <p><i>*Select the 1 Rec Per EAN check box to hide duplicate rows for products that have multiple suppliers or zones.*</i></p>	
<p>4. Click the product that you want to edit.</p> <p><i>*If a product has more than one EAN, the promo will only apply to those with the same Units/Pack.*</i></p>	
<p>5. Click the Promotions tab.</p> <p><i>*The grid lists all previous promotions; if you want to maintain history, create a new promotion rather than edit an old one.*</i></p>	
<p>6. Click  if you want to use the same Promotion Code and Start Date/End date as a selected promotion in the grid.</p> <p><i>*This is useful if you'll be creating several promos, to save reselecting these fields each time.*</i></p>	

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Hints and Tips

- ✓ **Loyalty Pricing** limits the promotion to customers when a card or AR code that has that price level is in the sale.

- ✓ There are three types of promotion:
 - new retail price
 - percentage off
 - dollar amount off.
 - ✓ You can't save a promotion with a [0] new price.
 - ✓ To transfer the promotion to a store:
 - Changes are **exported** to the affected store/s after scheduled tasks run (usually overnight). To export an immediate change (or a promotion effective today), refer to the [TECH-1e Manually Export Changes from HOS to a Store Fact Sheet](#).
 - HOST processes are also run at the store (automatically or manually, depending on how your system is configured), to import and insert a record on the **Promotions** tab on the stock record.
 - A ticket is automatically queued in the **Promotions On** option in Labels Wizard.
 - The promotion is effective at POS on the scheduled effective date after scheduled tasks have run; a **Promotion** icon will be displayed on the **BOS Stock Screen**.

<p>8. In the Promotion Code field, type a code for the promotion. <i>*Use any code naming conventions that exist.*</i></p>	
<p>9. In the Start Date field, select the date and time that the promotion will begin. <i>*Leave at the default (current date 12:01:00am) if you want the promotion effective immediately.*</i></p>	
<p>10. In the End Date field, select the date and time that the promotion will end.</p>	
<p>11. In the Loyalty Pricing field, select a loyalty group if required <i>*See Hints and Tips.*</i></p>	
<p>12. Select the On Hold flag if you don't want this promotion to be hosted to stores yet. <i>*You'll have to release (unselect the hold) the promo once you're ready for it to be exported.*</i></p>	
<p>13. Use the Description and Comments fields if you want to record any instructions.</p>	
<p>14. In the Affect fields: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • select the range of products the promotion applies to (e.g. this item, this sub range...) • select the type of promotion; e.g. <i>New Retail</i>. • type the new retail, percent-off amount, or dollar-off amount as applicable. <i>*A new Margin is automatically calculated.*</i> </p>	
<p>15. Select the location/s the promotion applies. <i>*Select the applicable category, and the Promo Active check box against the applicable locations.*</i> <i>*Defaults to All Stores every store.*</i></p>	
<p>16. Click </p> <p><i>*A summary is displayed if you created this as a sub-range promotion; click OK to continue.*</i> <i>*The new promotion is listed in the grid.*</i></p>

Procedure to Edit or Delete a Promotion

Hints and Tips

- ✓ If you edit a **sub-range** level promotion, it applies the change against all the other products in the sub-range as well.
 - If you change the promotion to affect 'single item', it deletes the promotions that were against the other products in the sub-range.
- ✓ If you edit an **active promotion**, it won't be changed at the store until HOST processes run (on the HOS and BOS).
- ✓ If you **delete an active promotion**, it will still be active until the physical deletion utility also runs to remove it (usually automatically overnight).
 - If you want deactivate an active promotion **effective immediately**, edit the end-date to the past (rather than delete the promotion), and manually export/import the change instead. Refer to [TECH-1e Manually Export Changes from HOS to a Store Fact Sheet](#).
