Request Cutting Desk Labels

Use a portable scanning device to produce a barcoded label for products sold by the metre. You need a portable printer attached to the device.

Procedure to Generate Cutting Desk Labels




Hints and Tips

- ✓ Press at any point, to cancel the label request for the entered product.
- ✓ You can also request a ticket by entering the **manufacturer code** at step 6.
- ✓ If you enter a **stock code** or a **manufacturer's code** that has multiple EANS linked to it, the system double-beeps and prompts you to select the specific EAN required.

Multiple Stock Code for 100062, please enter an EAN.
- ✓ The **Price Per Metre** that populates is either:
 - the price embedded in the scanned barcode
 - the price recorded in SUREfire, adjusted for any promotional or loyalty pricing applicable.
- ✓ The **Final Price** is calculated as **[Length] x [Price/Metre]**.

✓ **Field definitions:**

EAN	barcode on product
S/Code	ordering code for the default Supplier
UPP	Units per selling pack
SOH	Stock on Hand (units)
Supp	default supplier's code
C.Qty	units per order case
N.Ret	normal selling price, including GST
C.Ret	active promotional selling price including GST

1.	Attach the portable printer to the device.							
2.	From the main screen on the device, double-tap the SUREfire Internet program.							
3.	Enter your Operator ID & PIN , & press <input type="button" value="Login"/> . <i>*The functions displayed are determined by the PDA Staff Type set in the BOS Operator Details function.*</i>							
4.	Press <input type="button" value="Labels"/> .							
5.	Select Cut. Desk . <i>*You may need to scroll down to see this option.*</i>							
6.	Scan the EAN barcode or stock code on the product or ticket. <i>*Alternatively, key-enter it and press [>>] or Ent.*</i> <i>*Press <input type="button" value="Clear"/> if you entered the wrong product.*</i> <i>*The Price/Metre is populated; you can click in the field to change it if required – use a decimal place.*</i>							
7.	In the Length field, enter the number of metres being purchased. <i>*Use a decimal place [.] to enter a part metre; e.g. [1], [1.1],[0.8], [.8].*</i> <i>*The Final Price is automatically populated.*</i>							
8.	Press <input type="button" value="Print"/> or Ent. <i>*A barcoded label prints from the portable printer.*</i>							
9.	Apply the adhesive label to the product.
