### Hints and Tips

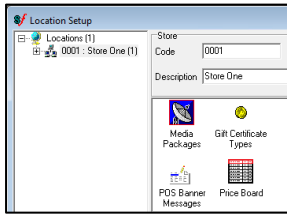
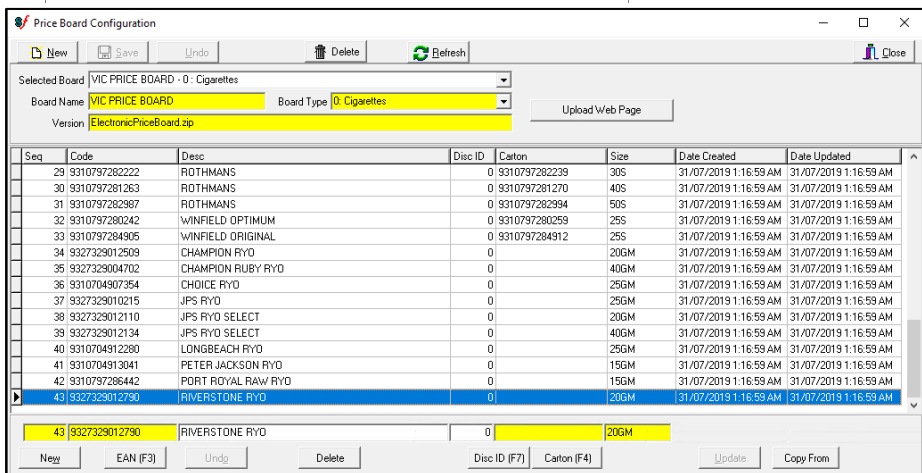
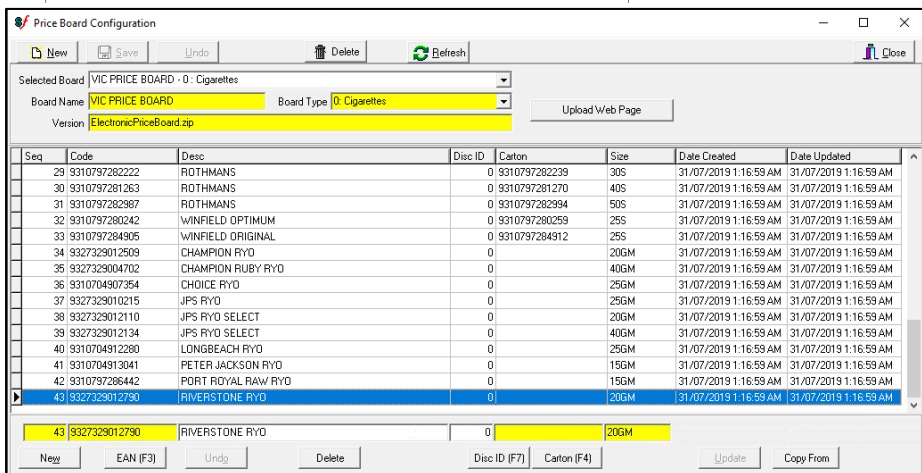

- ✓ The **Sequence** controls the order that products are displayed on the price board. This is autogenerated and cannot be edited.
- ✓ **Each row in the price board** can represent a single product, a few products, or a sub-range of products. However, the **EAN** field always only uses a single EAN to determine pricing.
- ✓ Some items will be sold as only packets, but others will also have cartons available. **Carton price** and single price are displayed separately on the board. You need to set this up manually by linking the Carton, so that the board displays the pricing for both options.
- ✓ **Showing Discounts**
  - In some States, it's legal to see cigarettes at a discount price in pack of two. The discounting capability of the Price Board can only display '2-for' pricing.
  - An automatic discount (New Price for Item or New Price for Item Group) is configured in Discount Wizard. The discount is usually re-used (with updated dates) as the 2-for price offer comes available.
  - If **Discount ID** is added against a product in the Pricing Board, and the discount is active, the price displayed will equal the New Price x Min Discount Qty.
- ✓ The Price Board webpage is designed to refresh the product content every 15 minutes.

Optionally search for or enter the <b>Disc ID</b> if there's a '2-for' offer for this item.</p> <p>e. Click <b>Carton</b> to search for the carton if this line is for selling the carton quantity.</p>
9.	<p>If you are a Head Office user, click <b>Upload WebPage</b> and select the web page template zip file to use for this pricing board. <i>*Contact Support if you can't locate the file path. They can email the file or place it on your server.*</i> <i>*The zip file will be automatically deployed to the stores web server as part of scheduled tasks.*</i></p>	
10.	<p>Click <b>Save</b>. <i>* The price board is sent to the store/s via normal export/import store processes.*</i> <i>* A local utility SFPriceBoard.exe will merge the price board with current pricing within the BOS.</i> <i>*The price board is displayed onto a large TV screen, via a web server to the web browser running on the media device.*</i></p>	
11.	<p>If this is the first time a price board is being used in this location, contact Surefire Support to complete an installation process. <i>*There are several tasks to configure, including allocating the price board used for your State.*</i></p>	
12.	<p>Click the [x] at the top of the dialog box.</p>	
13.	<p>Click <b>Close</b> on the Location Set up dialog box.</p>

## Procedure to Maintain a Pricing Board

### Hints and Tips

- ✓ Click **Undo** at the top of the screen to cancel all changes since you last clicked **Save**.
  - The **Undo** at the bottom of the screen is only used to cancel the insertion of a new row (EAN), or deletion of a row.
  
- ✓ The utility SFPriceBoard.exe is used to transfer the data to the web page.
  - It runs in conjunction with DealPromoCalc on a daily basis.
  - It refreshes the product content every 15 minutes.
  - It can also be manually run by the store staff, at times where an immediate correction is required. You'll find the shortcut in the same desktop folder as your other shortcuts (such as Send to Scales).
