In-store Points Promotion

If your business uses a points-based loyalty program and/or a rewards stamps program, you can award additional points to a product for a limited time.

Hints and Tips

- ✓ If your store is Head Office managed, check your business's policy regarding setting up points promotions at store level.
- ✓ The **Points** tab also lists any Head Office point's promotions imported from HOST.
 - If your store has created an in-store point's promotion effective at the same time as a HOS point's promotion, the promotion offering the highest number of points is applied at POS.
- ✓ The normal point's per dollar amount is set in **POS Config.** -> **Account** tab -> **Loyalty** tab.
- ✓ The stock record **Summary Information** section lists the **Current Loyalty Points** earned when the product is purchased.
 - If there isn't an active point's promotion, this is the **Current Sell Price** multiplied by the points per dollar configured.

- If there's an active **point's promotion**, this is the new total points; changing the current sell price will have no impact on the points issued for the duration of the point promotion.

Procedure to Create a Points Promotion

1.	From the BOS Tools menu, select Stock Functions , then Stock . <i>*Or click the Stock Maintenance icon.*</i>	
2.	In the EAN Code field, type, or search for, the EAN that you want to change. <i>*If a product has more than one EAN, the promotion will only apply to those with the same Units Per Pack.*</i>	
3.	Click the Points tab.	
4.	Click	
5.	In the Loyalty Code field, type an identifier for this promotion. <i>*You may use the number of weeks it runs for.*</i>	
6.	In the Start Date field, select the date and time that the promotion will begin. <i>* Defaults to the current day; See Hints and Tips.*</i>	
7.	In the End Date field, select the date and time that the promotion will end.	
8.	In the Affect field, select the range of products the promotion applies to. <i>*You can set it to only this product or all products in the same category as this product (such as sub-range, range, or department).*</i>	

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Hints and Tips

- ✓ When there is an active **Bonus Stamps Points** promotion:
 - the customer receives the normal loyalty points for the product (if loyalty is enabled) AND the extra bonus stamp points.
 - the bonus stamp points are not added to the customer's loyalty points accumulation.

- ✓ The sum of any loyalty points and bonus points in a sale is used to calculate the number of stamps awarded. Points do not round up.
 - For example, a customer buys a slab of coke for \$14.57. This product has a bonus points promotion offering 20 bonus points. So $14 + 20 = 34$ stamp points earned.
 - If the points : stamps ratio is 5:1, then the customer earns 6 stamps (34/5).
 - See Tech-2n Offer a Rewards Stamps Program for more information.

- ✓ The point's promotion becomes active at POS on the scheduled date/time after scheduled tasks have run (usually overnight).

- ✓ To make a promotion effective at POS immediately, leave the **Start Date** at the default (current date at 12.01.00AM) and click **Update** after you've saved the promotion.

- ✓ SUREfire POS Config. also includes a department-level point's multiplier function. You can set different loyalty points for departments, for certain days of the week (or every day).

 - If there's a point's promotion and a department point's multiplier active at the same time, you nominate if the department multiplier is used or ignored.
