Hints and Tips


- ✓ **Important!!** If your business has a **full store load** pending from a supplier, this will be exported at the same time you manually export your changes. This will be a large file that may take a few hours to process.
- ✓ You can click  to view a summary of the number of changes exported.
- ✓ When the store applies the host changes:
 - **Deal Promo Calc** updates the stock records for changes effective today (removes the “pending change”)
 - **Price Update** sends any price changes effective today to the registers.

Manually Export Changes to a Store

Changes are usually configured to be transferred to stores during overnight automatic processing.

You can perform this task manually, especially if there are urgent changes to apply; the affected store/s must also manually import the change/s.

Procedure to Manually Export Changes to a Store

1.	From the desktop screen, double-click the SUREfire HOS folder.	
2.	Double-click the HOSExport shortcut.	
3.	If required, select an Effective Date to only export changes that have an effective date up to and including the selected date. <i>*Usually not used, as you want promotions and deals to be at stores sooner than their start date.*</i>	
4.	It's recommended that you select all the Export Changes for check boxes. <i>*Some changes impact in several ways, and it isn't always obvious which options you need to select (which may result in errors).*</i> <i>*Only records that have changed will be exported.*</i> <i>*The other filtering options aren't used.*</i>	
5.	Click  .	
6.	Click  .	
7.	Wait several minutes, and then call the affected store/s and ask them to complete their normal host processes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From the desktop screen, double-click the SUREfire BOS folder. • Double-click the Process HOST shortcut. • If the retail or promotion price has changed, print a new ticket from Labels Wizard. • Double-click the DealPromoCalc shortcut. • Double-click the PriceUpdate shortcut. • Double-click the SendtoSales shortcut if applicable. <i>*These tasks may be called something similar or combined into a single shortcut in your business.*</i>
